

Title: Popsicle Pop Art**Visual Arts Standard:**

- Objective(s):**
- Learn about the pop art movement.
 - Analyze pop art.
 - Create popsicle pop art.

- Essential Question(s):**
- What is pop art?
 - Who were prominent pop artists?
 - How can you create pop art?

Materials & Resources:

- 9x12 black paper
- Six 4x9 colored paper
- Sharpie
- Crayons
- Glue
- Scissors
- PowerPoint presentation

Activities:

- Introduce the lesson using the PowerPoint presentation.
- Discuss the importance of pop art in art history.
- Demonstrate how to assemble the colored paper and popsicle sticks.
- Students work independently to glue their background and popsicle sticks.
- Demonstrate how to draw and decorate the popsicles.
- Students work independently to draw, cut, glue and decorate their popsicles and background.
